

Our Program

Our students generally enroll to take credits at AEC for one of three reasons:

Manitoba Mature Student Diploma

A fast-track, 8-credit, fully recognized high school diploma, featuring regular high school credits, including Senior 4 (Grade 12) English and Mathematics.

Regular High School Completion

If you are within a few credits of achieving your regular 30-credit diploma, get the credits you need to graduate through evening or day study.

Academic Upgrading for Adults

As a high school graduate, you can take the high school credits you need for career advancement or post-secondary study.



Benefits of Enrolling at AEC

Adult-Focused. Our staff understand the needs and pressures adults face coming back to school and strive to accommodate their students while, at the same time, providing a high standard of education.

Teacher-Led Classes. At AEC, we have opted for teacher-led classes to provide the right amount of structure for our students. Students also benefit from interaction with other adult classmates.

Assessments. We provide assessments in mathematics and English so that students will be placed at an appropriate level of course work.

Academic Support. Through our two academic support staff, we are able to help students who request it.

Flexibility. We offer courses morning, afternoons and evenings over two semesters.

RPL. Through Recognition of Prior Learning, students can sometimes gain high school credits based on their life and/or employment experience.

Career Counselling. Students can speak to their teachers or the director for advice on career interests, post-secondary choices, goal-setting, resumes, job interviews and portfolios for credit.
